# FUNERAL GUIDE (For the Bereaved Family)

## Documents to be Submitted:

- Interment Application
- Passport copy of the Deceased
- · Certified true copy of the Death Certificate
- Certificate of Cremation
- Contribution money for Japanese Association Cebu Inc.
- Php30,000 for interment expenses (burial fee, alms, grave marker engraving, use of tents, tables and chairs, etc.)

### Meeting with the assigned Director regarding the date of interment

49<sup>th</sup> day is common.

### Order of Things on the Day of the Interment

- ① Be punctual. Assemble at the Japanese Cemetery and set up the flowers and the offerings.
- ② Chanting by a monk
- ③ Burning of incense sticks by the attendees
- ④ Burial
- ⑤ Speech by a member of the bereaved family (If food is served, guide the attendees)
- 6 Adjournment (Bring home the offerings)

### To Bring During the Interment:

- Ashes remains (to sign)
- Flowers (avoid roses with thorns, flowers with strong scent, and those with lots of pollen such as lily)
- · Offerings (fruits, vegetables, sweets, those that the deceased liked)
- Mineral water for the attendees
- Tip for the burial working crew (around PhP500)
